The GRANDMOTHER fights with her DAUGHTER-IN-LAW, converses with the spirit of her SON, drinks a cup of Milo and watches her GRANDDAUGHTER take her final march towards her deathbed in a kind of apocalyptic graphic novel meets Victorian-era toy theater, prompting the GRANDDAUGHTER to ask, "when is life worth living; when is death worth celebrating?"
