In/Visibility is an exercise that experiments with the possibilities (as well as limitations) of using light to express a play, stripped of actors and spoken words, in relation to a space.

Based loosely on the structure, circumstances, characters, emotions and themes of the script, this is an attempt to interpret and weave the story of Invisibility into the fabric of the Centre 42 Black Box as a room; and to work the character of this black box into the framework of the play.

To put the project in context, this piece is part of a thread of work that I have been exploring since 2007. A thread in which performance venues are engaged asthey-are – as historically, texturally and energetically charged rooms with their own stories to share – in conversations with light.

Space has always been the sole anchor in these previous works - the flow of light narratives were informed and inspired primarily by the rooms themselves.

In In/Visibility, however, the play Invisibility was chosen and introduced as a starting point, an alternative anchor and a form of intervention into this conversation between light and space. With space still playing an important role, the added element of a script informed and affected the choices and decisions made in the exposition of this particular black box.

I would like to thank Centre 42 for the invitation and for inspiring and making this experiment possible. I also want to thank you, the audience, for being part of this.
